As a Parent/Carer I shall:

- Make sure my child attends school regularly (aiming for attendance to be over 96%)
- Make sure they arrive on time, being in class by 8.55am
- Collect my child on time at the end of their school day
- Notify the school on the first day of absence if my child is unable to attend
- Encourage my child to take responsibility for his/her learning and complete any home learning tasks (providing a quiet environment for him/her to do this)
- Show an interest in my child's learning
- Support my child with their reading and share books regularly
- Encourage my child to join in extra-curricular activities that he/she is interested in
- Work with the school to try to make sure that my child behaves well, ensuring the safety of themselves and other children, getting in touch if there are any problems at home that may affect their learning or behaviour
- Set a good example to my own and other children when on school premises
- Approach the teachers and other staff, parents and pupils in a respectful manner
- Attend parents' evenings and any other discussions about my child's progress
- Respond to any school correspondence
- Ensure that my child comes to school dressed in school uniform and with PE kit
- Celebrate my child's school achievements and praise them for their efforts
- Refrain from using mobile phones/ hand held devices whilst on the school premises
- Ensure the school always have at least two emergency contact numbers
