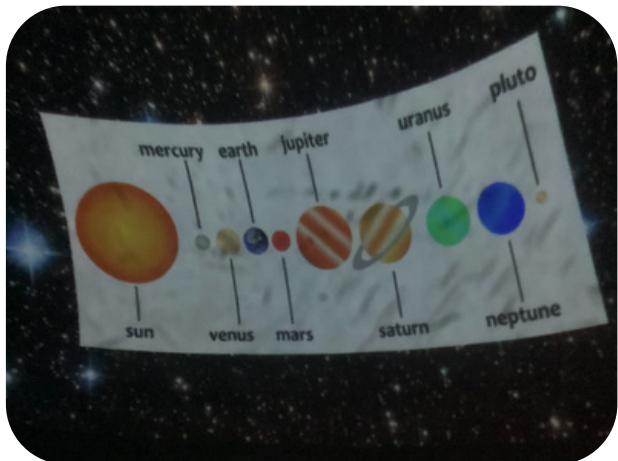




Science Week Newsletter

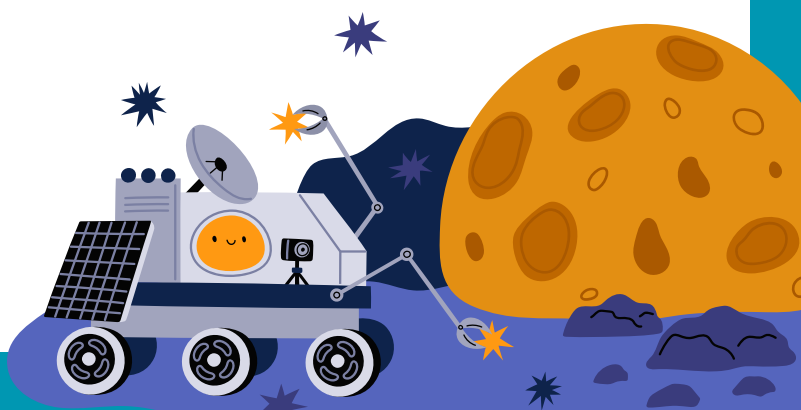


The 'Moon Buggy Competition' was a huge success with lots of imaginative entries. Thank you at home for all your support with this.
